

BASEBALL BC PROVINCIAL TOURNAMENT TEAMS

13U AA & AAA, 15U AA

The leagues in District 6 will be participating in the Baseball BC Provincial Tournaments in three areas: 13U AA, 13U AAA and 15U AA. Information regarding tryouts for the 15U AA will be sent out shortly. **The following information is for the 13 U AA and AAA teams.**

Player Eligibility:

Must have played for one of the Little Leagues in District 6 during the 2019 season – Hastings, New Westminster, Richmond, South Vancouver or Trout Lake Little League

For the 13U AA & AAA teams - Must be 13 years or younger by December 31, 2019 (cannot turn 14 in 2019).

Assessments:

- Sunday, July 14 @ 6 pm, King George Park (4100 No. 5 Road, Richmond, Cambie & No. 5)
- Monday, July 15 @ 6 pm, King George Park
- Tuesday, July 16 @ 6 pm, King George Park (tentative)

Fees:

- Once player has been selected onto a provincial team, the fee is \$125. The fee includes a tournament souvenir t-shirt (if provided by the host). Players must provide their own pants, socks and belts (color TBA). Hats and playing equipment will be provided.
- Additional fees for advancing to the Westerns or National tournament (see below)

Baseball BC Tournaments:

a) 13U AA

- Provincial is in Chilliwack from August 8-11(Thursday to Sunday)
- Winner qualifies for Westerns August 16-18 (Friday to Sunday) in Strathmore, AB

Financial Commitment – Advancing to the Westerns. All coaching staff and player must pay \$250 each. Baseball BC will cover airfare costs to the Western. Teams and players are responsible for their own hotels, meals and local transportation.

b) 13U AAA

- Provincial is in Burnaby from August 8-11 (Thursday to Sunday)
- Provincial winner qualifies for Nationals August 22-25 (Thursday to Sunday) in Repentigny, PQ
- Runner-up qualifies for Westerns August 15-18 (Thursday to Sunday) in Cloverdale, BC

Financial Commitment –

a) **Team advances to the Westerns**, each player and coach must pay a fee of \$250 each.

b) **If the AAA team advances to the Nationals**, each player and coach must pay a fee of \$500 each.

Baseball BC will cover transportation costs to all out of province National Championships. Baseball BC will pay the \$4,000 Baseball Canada accommodation fee for the event in addition to hotel costs for the Tuesday night if required. Teams/players are responsible for their own meals. Baseball BC will book flights for 21 individuals for all out of province tournaments. Should a team not require this number of flights for players and coaches they will be required to pay the full cost of unused flights, which can be resold to the parents. The Chef de Mission's flight is included in these numbers.

All fees for Westerns and Nationals are payable to Baseball BC within five days of qualification.

Baseball BC will select and provide funding for the Chef de Mission for each out of province Western or National.
